The Grammar School of Laucha, situated in the county "Burgenlandkreis" in the south of Saxony-Anhalt, was founded in 1991. Its new building was opened in 1993. Apart from the manufacturing of bells, Laucha has also been famous for gliding for more than 80 years. Even as early as 1993 the first steps were taken to introduce gliding at the Grammar School. But the regional bond to the "Burgenlandkreis" is not only created by a great interest in flying and gliding but also by activities related to the traditional viniculture in the wine-growing area on the rivers Saale and Unstrut. The Choir, Theatre Club, several sports activities (e.g. football, volleyball, gymnastics) etc. are also offered here The Association of Sponsors/Promoters (parents, teachers, former students and local business and political representatives) supports a lot of activities.
